ICLIF LEADERSHIP ENERGY AWARDS (ILEA)

ILEA WINNERS OF 2016



Arunachalam Muruganantham received the [Social Enterprise Award](#) for his work in breaking down the stigma surrounding female menstruation, particularly in impoverished communities globally, and inventing a simple machine to cost-effectively produce sanitary pads.



Mohammad Rizan Hassan, Founder of 1 Belia, 1 Kemahiran (1B1K) and TEKAT Automotive Centre, received the [Corporate Employee Award](#) for providing marginalised Malaysian youth access to educational and employment opportunities so they can become contributing members of society.



Srikanth Bolla, was the recipient of the [Business Owner Award](#) for providing, through Bollant Industries, employment and career opportunities to more than 450 differently-abled individuals who might otherwise struggle to find meaningful work.

AWARD CATEGORIES

The Iclif Leadership Energy Awards are not just another vehicle to recognise business achievement, but pay tribute to those in Asia who use their personal leadership energy to make a positive, sustainable impact in their organisations or communities. These Leadership Energy Champions are selected based on a broad range of criteria that considers vision & strategy (shaped by the deeply held values), personal conviction, measurable results, commercial or social impact, and sustainability.

Winners are selected in three categories:

Corporate Employee (Individual/Team)

Corporate employee means individual or team under the employment of either the government, public listed company or private entity.

Business Owner/Founder

Business owner/founder means owner/founder of business entities in an attempt to profit from the successful operations of the company or owner of an entrepreneurial venture. Typically start-ups of newly emerged, fast-growing businesses, generally involved in the design and implementation of the innovative processes of the development, validation and research for target markets.

Social Enterprise Owner/Founder

Social Enterprise owner/founder means owner/founder of organisations that apply commercial strategies to improve human and environmental well-being. This may include maximising social impact alongside profits for external shareholders. Their social mission is as core to their success as any potential profit.

Leadership Energy Champions in each category will receive a **cash reward of US\$15,000** and a plaque. The winners will be announced at the Leadership Energy Summit Asia on 8th & 9th November 2017 in Kuala Lumpur.
